EAA CHAPTER 640, HAYMEADOW FLYERS

Meeting July 14, 2012 in the Tomahawk Airport terminal lobby

Meeting: President Keith Mathews called the meeting to order at 1:08 pm, after we were done eating the nice lunch provided by Carol Marvin. 12 members and guests were present. Keith thanked Carol for lunch.

Keith asked for corrections or additions to the June minutes, as printed in the July *Haymeadow Flyer*. There were none.

Keith asked for corrections or additions to the June Treasurer's report, as printed in the July *Haymeadow Flyer*. Motion by John Jirovek, seconded by Junior Ricci to accept them as printed.

No new members or guests were present.

Old Business:

Chapter Board Meeting: Keith said that he is still attempting to schedule a Board of Director's meeting about Payzer Gift, but so far has had no luck getting Board members together. Syd asked Keith what the actual purpose of the Board meeting would be. Keith said it was so the Board would make the final decision. Syd said that the Board decided last year that the membership would make the final decision. Syd said he would look in the minutes from last year's meetings to verify this. This item was left unsettled. Keith reminded everyone that the suggestion period for the use of the Bob Payzer gift is still open.

New Business:

Ford Tri-Motor: Keith said that he had been contacted by EAA asking if our chapter would host the Ford Tri-Motor at the Wausau Airport near the end of August or a weekend in September or October. They said that the Ford has a 78' wingspan, and would have to be kept in a hangar each night. Keith said he had not yet talked to John Chmiel, but it didn't look like hangar space would be available. Syd said he would talk to John and to EAA, and made a motion that if possible, our chapter would host the Ford. John Jirovec seconded, and the motion passed.

Tomahawk Fly-In: Ray Marvin passed out flyers for the Tomahawk Fly-In on August 19 (see flyer below) and encouraged us to attend.

I Learned About Flying from That! – by Charlie Turner. Charlie told flying his motor glider and having an engine failure due to fuel mismanagement. He said that we should always have a checklist available and use it, and he was embarrassed that he did not.

Another I Learned About Flying from That! – by Harry Gladwin. Harry told us about the time that he took off but realized that he had left the gust lock on the ailerons of his Taylorcraft, and was very concerned. Luckily, the gust lock came loose over Burlington and fell to the ground.

Project Reports – Dave Conrad, who completed his Wittman Tailwind last spring, said that he and Syd had gone to 5,000 feet and he pushed the throttle full forward. They waited until the speed stabilized, read the airspeed indicator, and later figured out the true airspeed. The Tailwind trued out at 212 mph. **Dave Harm** said that he is working on his RV-9 project and has finished the tail surfaces and will order the wing kit next. He is looking for a Lycoming O-320 engine.

Next meeting – will be at a picnic table at the Bob Payzer Memorial Fly-In at Boulder Junction after lunch.

The meeting was adjourned at 1:47 pm, with a motion by John Jirovec seconded by Dave Conrad.
